

Wandler Family Foundation Scholarship - North Platte

The Scholarship:

A Scholarship Recipient¹ may receive up to \$2,000.00 in scholarship funds, paid directly to the individual's chosen, accredited 4-year college, for tuition and fees for the fall semester of the Scholarship Recipient's freshman year.

If the Scholarship Recipient maintains a 3.5 GPA through their freshman year, verified by transcripts submitted to the Selection Committee by July 15th following that freshman year, an additional \$1,000.00 in scholarship funds will be made available for the sophomore year.

A Selection Committee will review all applications that follow the Application Requirements (stated below) and choose the Scholarship Recipient from those applications.

*If no Eligible Students apply in any given year, the Selection Committee reserves the right to not provide scholarship funds in that year.

Deadline: Applications must be postmarked no later than February 28th, 2023. Applications should be mailed to:

*If the application is postmarked after the deadline date, the applicant will be ineligible for scholarship consideration, unless good cause (as solely defined by the current Selection Committee) is shown.

¹ The Scholarship Recipient is the individual selected by the Selection Committee to receive the year's scholarship funds from a pool of Eligible Students. An Eligible Student is a student of North Platte High School, a member of the soccer or basketball teams, has a GPA higher than 3.5, who will attend an accredited 4-year college, and who will graduate from high school by July of the year of application, and who is not a Relative of a WFF Stakeholder (officers, directors, and founders) or of the Selection Committee members. However, if an Eligible Student is otherwise eligible except from being related to a Selection Committee member, they may be considered if the related Selection Committee member removes himself or herself from the Selection Committee for that year. A Relative is defined as any person that would inure a benefit on a WFF Stakeholder of Selection Committee member if that person were to receive the scholarship funds.

<u>Scholarship Award Notification Date:</u> The Selection Committee will notify the Award Recipient on or before April 3rd, 2023.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Cover Page must include:

- a. Name of scholarship applying for
- b. Applicant's full legal name
- c. Applicant's full physical address
- d. Applicant's full mailing address (if different from above), phone number, and email address
- e. High school currently attending
- f. High School GPA
- g. ACT or SAT score

2. One letter of recommendation in a sealed envelope

- 3. One official high school transcript
- 4. One copy of ACT or SAT results

5. Personal Statement

- a. Please write a short statement about your family, work experience, community involvement, and hobbies
- b. Personal statement should be a minimum of 100 words and a maximum of 500 words

6. Essay

- a. Essay Question: What do you expect to do with your college degree and how has participation in varsity athletics helped prepare you for the future?
- b. Essay question should be a minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 1,000 words

INTERVIEW (Optional): Recipient, if desired, will also have the opportunity to speak to a committee member of their choice about their education and career aspiration goals and questions in a 45-minute remote session (after notification of selection).
